Temple of God.

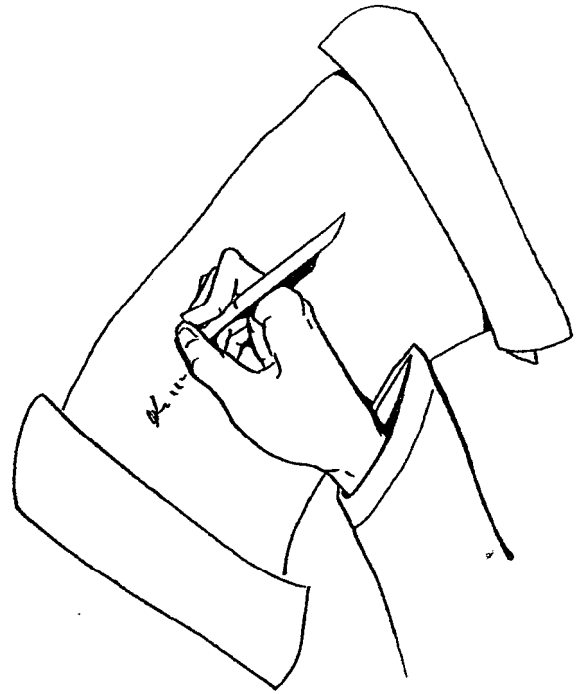


While the Temple was being cleaned, Hilkiah, the high priest, found the Bible scroll.

(Deuteronomy 17:18)



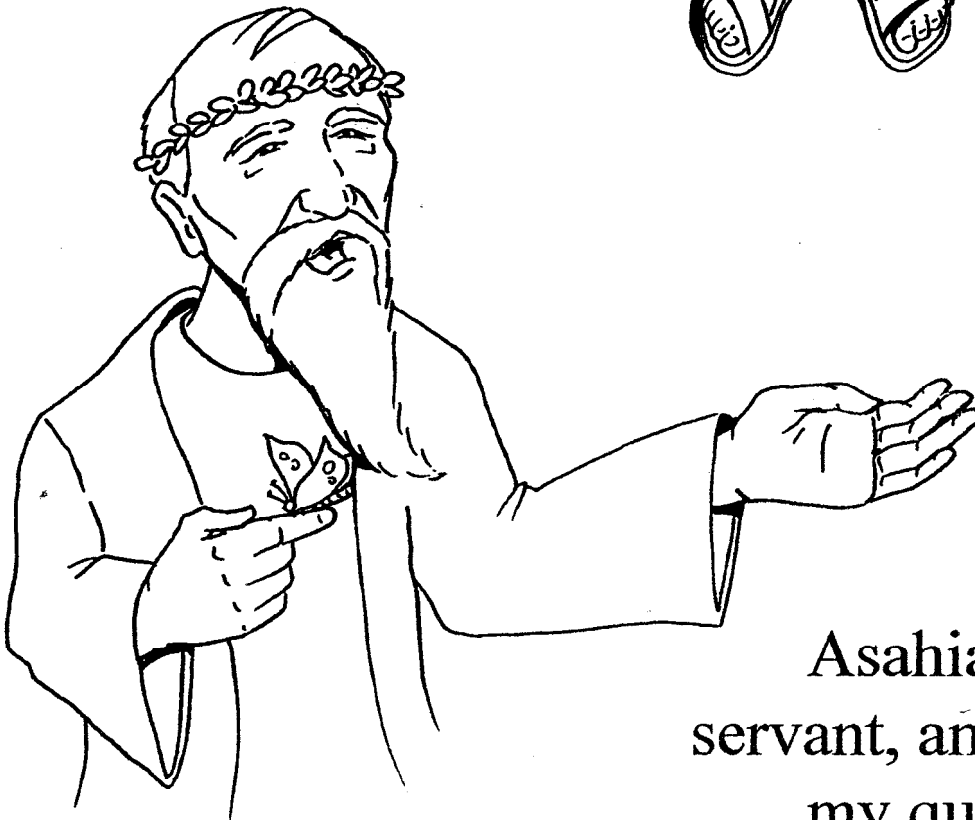
This I began to

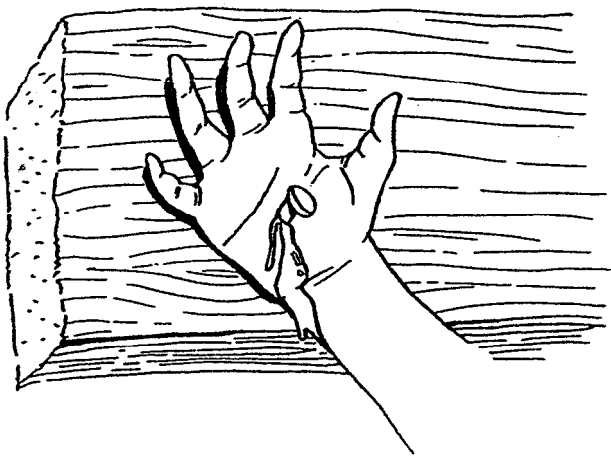
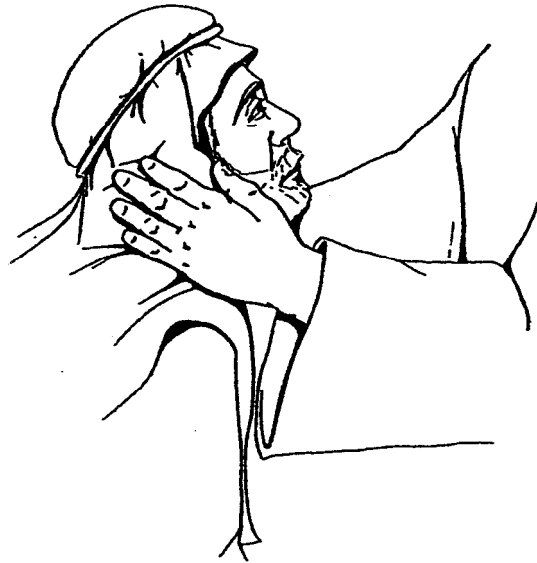
